The romance, however, describes the Maules as possessing some of the traits known to have been characteristic of the Hawthornes: for example, so long as any of the race were to be found, they had been marked out from other men—not strikingly, nor as with a sharp line, but with an effect that was felt rather than spoken of—by an hereditary characteristic of reserve.
